NO-CONTACT EXPECTATIONS

The students listed above agree to temporarily end direct and indirect contact with one another. This agreement is intended to prevent further conflict and support safety; it does not determine fault or require students to give up the right to report a concern.

1	No direct contact. Do not talk to, call, text, message, write to, tag, mention, or contact another student listed in this agreement.
2	No messages through other people. Do not ask friends, family members, or anyone else to carry messages, get information, or confront someone for you.
3	No online posts about the conflict. Do not post, share, comment on, react to, tag, forward, or create photos, videos, rumors, or other content about a listed student or the situation.
4	No mean, threatening, or provoking behavior. Do not approach, follow, surround, stare at, gesture toward, threaten, tease, mock, confront, or try to restart the conflict.
5	Stay apart. Follow staff directions about seats, lines, recess, lunch, arrival/dismissal, the bus, activities, or other temporary safety arrangements.
6	Do not involve other students. Do not spread rumors, ask students to take sides, plan to get even, or ask others to pressure or provoke a listed student.
7	Walk away and tell an adult. Immediately tell a trusted adult about contact, threats, retaliation, online activity, or safety concerns. Do not respond or try to get even.

PERMITTED REPORTING, REQUIRED CONTACT, AND REVIEW

This agreement does not stop a student from telling a parent/guardian, teacher, counselor, administrator, school employee, police officer, or other trusted adult about a safety concern or asking for help. If students must be in the same class, activity, bus, or emergency situation, they must follow staff directions and speak only when necessary.

Duration and response to violations: This agreement stays in effect through the review/expiration date above unless an administrator changes it in writing. Staff will review any reported violation. School support, safety steps, or discipline may follow under district policy and applicable law; consequences are not automatic.

Acknowledgment: By signing above, each student confirms that an adult explained the agreement, answered questions, and made sure the student understood the expectations. Students should tell the administrator if anything is unclear.
