Before any referral, PVUSD documents school interventions and provides written notice of the reason for referral.

Continued violations may result in additional interventions, discipline when legally authorized, or referral to the Behavioral SARB/SARB process. Please discuss the importance of being safe, respectful, and responsible with your student.
